Primary Accountabilities Include:

- Fire Inspections
- Public Relations and Education Services

Education/Experience Requirements:

- NFPA 1001 Level 1 and Level 2 Certification
- Valid Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) registration with Alberta College of Paramedics
- Valid Canadian Physical Assessment Test (CPAT) Certification
 - (CPAT certification can be acquired from Calgary Fire Department Wellness Centre – Please contact 403-873-2352 to arrange.)

Skills and Attributes:

- Applicants will be required to pass a written fire knowledge examination and interview process
- Preference will be given to candidates who hold a valid Class 3 Driver's license with an air brake (Q) endorsement
- These positions may involve working 24- hours shift rotations

Salary Range: \$27.20 per hour (currently under review) and a comprehensive benefit and pension package

Application Process:

Candidates are invited to provide a cover letter which addresses the qualifications listed above, and their resume. A current CPAT Certificate and copy of ACP registration **must** be presented at the written examination which is expected to take place the second week of January 2012.

Applications will be accepted to **December 22, 2011** and must be submitted on-line to Human Resources via the City of Airdrie webpage – www.airdrie.ca .

Successful applicants will also be required to provide an acceptable criminal record check including vulnerable sector and driver abstract.
